## Always in His Peace

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ Jesus,

In our church calendar year we have entered into the season of Ordinary Time. It is now summer for me! Summer now! Then what happened to June!?! Summer for me is a time to get some things done in the parish and in my personal life. Time to do those “home and self-improvements projects”. In the parish it’s plant a tree, throw some mulch, paint a room and have to fix something. In my personal life it is the above at my mom’s house and also exercise every morning. It is also how about unpacking those boxes I did not unpack four years ago and other house or office cleaning tasks. I did plant some flowers at mom’s over Memorial Day weekend, and I have exercised a few times, but...

Well, in the parish we will be doing some things.

At SMG we will be having the church and parish center re-roofed (shingles). We have accepted a bid and it will be completed when the roofers are able to schedule it. The cost is \$22,000

At MOLOP we will be having new HVAC units installed for our upper level hall. (The lower level is not air-conditioned and the rooms have hot water heat). The bids were accepted earlier this spring and had to be special made. They have now arrived and will be installed when it can be scheduled. The cost is \$20,000.

At MOLOP we have also identified other areas of our buildings that need our attention for replacement and repair and have prioritized them. These include our church boiler (that also provides heat for our hall’s lower level and for the small hall in the upper level), zoning for the heat (for efficiency) and church roof (the pitched parts and not the flat parts). Earlier (last year) we made repairs to the hall roof which extended the life of the existing roof and bought us some time before it’s need for replacement.

At MOLOP we in the process of accepting a bid for replacing our gutters and downspouts on the rectory. On the main part of the house they were damaged by ice this past winter and the gutters and downspouts on the garage addition needed to be improved as well. Hopefully this will address the water problem in the basement.

Well, here’s to oh sweet, “Summertime, Summertime, O Oh Summertime”!
