## Always in His Peace

Dear Parishioners,

In two weeks we will celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the life of the early church. In today's Gospel we hear Jesus tell his disciples, and he tells us as well, that he will ask the Father to send another Advocate, the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth.

The Holy Spirit, the love God has for us all, is reaffirmed on Pentecost Sunday. Today we are told how to be open to the Holy Spirit. Jesus does not mess around. He goes straight to the point. Keep the commandments.

If we love Jesus we will keep his commandments. If we keep his commandments we will love Jesus.

In other words: Love Jesus = Keeping His commandments.

What commandments, some may ask? Well, we've got the Big Ten. That should be on the radar. But let us cut to the chase as Jesus did, when he said this to the question "Which is the greatest commandment?" (as found in the Gospel of Matthew 22: 37-40).

37 Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.'[a] 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'[b] 40

May we do this, beginning first in our homes, then with those with whom God has made.

And may you have a prayerful and beautiful Memorial Day as we remember to give thanks to those who gave all.
