Holy Thursday Pilgrimage: to Seven Churches The Seven Churches visitation (or Pilgrimage) is credited as beginning in Rome with St. Philip Neri in the 1500's. Neri would lead groups of faithful to visit each of the seven basilicas of Rome on Holy Thursday night as a way of keeping watch with Christ as though at the Garden of Gethsemane before his passion.

Each visit calls on the faithful to reflect on the seven final places Jesus went from his arrest on Holy Thursday to his death on Good Friday.
